



## Index

This index provides a different method of locating patterns, illustrations, and descriptions than the table of contents. Because the patterns for the main parts of ensembles—bodices, polonaises, draperies, and skirts—can be exchanged to achieve the desired style, they are indexed separately, in addition to the complete ensembles. If exactly the same pattern (such as one for a foundation skirt) is given with several different ensembles, only the first instance of it is indexed separately. Smaller sections, such as sleeves, are also interchangeable but are not indexed separately. Because some ensembles and accessories have the same name, different references apply to different ones, even if the page number is the same.
